Frost Valley YMCA's administration and dining services are preparing to partner with the town of Denning to support local families who require meal assistance. Several months ago, supervisor David Brooks and Town Clerk Joy Monforte along with Councilmen Mike Dean, Paul Schoonmaker, Kevin Smith, and Greg Vurckio offered a confidential survey on the town website to be filled out by any residents interested in receiving meals through this program. Based on the responses, the group has decided to move forward with the free meal program.

Starting January 2016, participating families and individuals will be able to receive frozen meals from the Denning Town Hall. These meals will be delivered weekly on Wednesdays for participants to pick up. Deliveries may be an option for those with transportation issues.

Frost Valley YMCA, a year-round camp and retreat center in Claryville, will prepare the meals in its state-of-the-art kitchen and work with local volunteers who will help distribute the meals to the Town Hall.
